

Library Opening Times

Books, Reference, Official Publications; AV material.

The Library stocks a wide range of books and AV resources in all subject areas which are available for loan or reference. These include the Main General Loan Collection; Reference Collection; Short Loan Collection; Official Publications; EU Section; Audio Visual Collection. Standard Loan items are available for loan. Short Loan items are issued for 2 hours in the library. Official Publications and Reference books are for use in the library only.

Items can be renewed automatically up to a maximum of 3 times, unless requested by another patron You are responsible for all items that you borrow until they are returned to the Library. If the items that you borrow become overdue and are returned late, your account will be suspended and you will not be able to borrow books until the suspension has expired.

Journals

The library stocks approximately 50 journals in all subject areas and current journals are shelved on the first floor of the North Campus Library; older copies of journals are shelved on the second floor. Current newspapers are kept on the Ground Floor.

Library Catalogue & Multisearch

The **library catalogue** is a complete list of all items held in the Library. The default search is keyword and you can then search by title, author, subject, keyword, by clicking on advanced search in the results screen. When searching for an item on the library catalogue, you should note the call number of the book and its location code. Items can also be reserved on the library catalogue but you will need your university card number to use this facility.

Multisearch is the default search box on the library home page; it searches both online and physical items held by the library, including full-text subscribed e-books, online resources, electronic journal articles, etc. It also includes print books and journals. A simple one word keyword search can bring back millions of results so it is recommended that you use the Advanced Search features.

My Library

Using the My Library feature on the library website you can see how many books you have out at the moment, and request books that are checked out to other patrons. There is also an option to order interlibrary loans online. You may also see your reading history. To avail of all these services you must log in to your My Library account by clicking on the icon on the library website.

Online Resources


The library subscribes to a large number of key online resources to aid you in your study, these can be accessed off site as well as on campus These include:

- The A-Z of Online Journals: This resource enables the user to check all of our online databases for a particular journal title.
- eBooks: The library subscribes to the e-book package Proquest eBook Central. The library also holds a selection of over 2,000 purchased titles on our library catalogue
- **Online Journals :** The Library subscribes to tens of thousands of full-text academic journals through our databases.

- **Subject Guides (LibGuides)** Subject specific information is available through the subject guides on the Library Web Page—accessed via the **LibGuides** Link.
- Referencing, citations and avoiding plagiarism (LibGuides) Available online through the web page via the LibGuides Link, this page includes links to all the Institute's Referencing information including the IMCP guidelines.

Library Resource Rooms

Reading/Research Rooms - The Cube North Campus; South Campus Reading Room

Both the North and South Campus offer Reading Room/Research access with PC and wi-fi laptop connectivity outside normal library opening hours: The Cube in the North Campus; the main Library Reading Room area in the South Campus. All study spaces and Pcs need to be booked

Audio Visual Room North Campus

Open access room with 3 PCs and 2 Apple Macs; dual format VCRs; Blu-ray DVDs; headphones available. There are 2 bookable pcs in this area

Assistive Technology Room North Campus

Open access resource room with 3 PCs; two scanners, magnifier. Software including: Kurzweill 1,000; Inspiration; Word Shark; Words Work; Dragon naturally Speaking; JAWS; Zoom Text; Duxbury; Dolphin Easy Converter; Text Help Read & Write Gold. The room has to be booked as a whole space.

User Education Room / Training Room — North Campus

Bookable by staff for specialist tutorials, training, presentations: 20 PCs; blu-ray DVD; surround-sound; videoconferencing facilities; interactive whiteboard. Book online on library website. Please note: not bookable for general classroom use.

Click & Collect Service


This services enables students and staff to request available general lending books from the North Campus Library and collect them at the Click and Collect Collection points on either campus. Please see the library website for details.
